**\*If you receive your period, (cycle day one, the first day of a full flow red) after 5pm, call to speak to a nurse the following day. There is no urgency with any treatment plan to start that night. \***

11	You will come in for blood work and ultrasound on cycle day 11, you will receive a call from your nurse by the end of the day with results and instructions		
	You might need to come in for several blood work and ultrasound exams until we see you have a follicle measurable at 17mm or greater or until we see that your starting to ovulate on your own		
	You could be instructed based upon you testing that you would need to take a 1 time subcutaneous injection called OVIDREL (Ovidrel causes your body to ovulate)		OVIDREL
	If Ovidrel is taken and you have day5 embryo(s) you will have a transfer 7 days after Ovidrel injection. if you do not need Ovidrel and have day5 embryo(s) transfer will be 6 days later		
			You will be instructed to take Progesterone & estrogen supplement by your nurse

		The day before your embryo transfer expect an email from a nurse with timing and instructions for the transfer		
		Blood Pregnancy test happen 10 days after transfer
